The 'Ua'u (Hawaiian Petrel) is an endangered seabird that nests only in Hawai'i. Before humans came to Maui, these birds nested all over the island from the beach up the slopes of Haleakalā to the summit at 10,000 feet. Like all seabirds, they are important to island ecosystems because they bring nutrients from the ocean onto land.
