

Internship Opportunity Announcement Posted: December 2023

Learning Endeavors is currently seeking:

- Student Intern (Post-Secondary Student or Recent High School Graduate) that currently Resides on the Island of Molokai
- Assistance on LE's Kōkua Moloka'i *Expeditions for Youth* program.

The overarching goals of each expedition are for youth to discover indigenous local knowledge, identify ecological issues, explore current stewardship strategies at each site, and engage in helpful action. Along their journey, student interns will capture key moments of their experiences on video to embed in the Kōkua Moloka'i PSA videos.

- **Responsibilities** will include capturing images and video of each expedition and producing a short 30 second PSA. Each video should give voice to the positive efforts underway at the location and share needed action into the future to help the watersheds of Moloka'i. Each video should show youth in action on expeditions and try to inspire the wider community to become stewards of their own watershed. For each two-day expedition for youth, two distinct videos will be produced.
- **Requirements & Time Frame:** The time frame for this internship is Spring/Summer 2024 -March through July. About ten to fifteen hours per month on average, with the most time being March and again in Summer, during each two day expedition.
- **Application Deadline** is January 19 2024. Internship start date is February 20, 2024 and ends July 31, 2024 Detailed schedule for expeditions to be provided soon.
- **Qualifications:** The ideal candidate for this position has a passion for video production and/or taking care of the 'āina. The funding for this program is from a NOAA BWET Grant.
- Compensation: Intern will receive \$400 for full participation in the internship.
