

Maui Nui Seabird Recovery Project



The Wedge-tailed Shearwater is known as ‘Ua‘u Kani in Hawai‘i. Its name means “calling or moaning petrel”. These birds are able to start breeding at 5 years old, when they return from the sea to their home colony. They usually mate for life with the same partner and have 1 egg per year. The oldest known bird was recorded at 29 years old!
